

SUPPORTIVE PROGRAMS

WiscJobsForVets

Wisconsin is first in the nation to offer a streamlined recruitment process to fill State agency jobs by hiring qualified veterans with a 30% or greater service connected disability. Job opportunities range from:

- ◆ Administrative to Legal
- ◆ Procurement to IT
- ◆ Logistics to Health Care

Fidelity Bonding

Fidelity Bonding is a federal program that provides bonds to individuals who are not eligible for commercial bonding. There are no fees for veterans and employers to participate in the program, and employers are not required to complete paperwork.

Wisconsin GI Bill

The Wisconsin GI Bill covers the cost of tuition for veterans at any higher education institution in the University of Wisconsin System or the Wisconsin Technical College System.

Apprenticeship Program

Veterans in Piping and Helmets to Hardhats are apprenticeship training programs consisting of classroom instruction and On-the-Job Training (OJT), specifically developed for veterans.
