Dear Members of the Dislocated Worker Unit:

Unimin Corporation will be idling production at its facility located in Tunnel City, Wisconsin located at 20319 State Highway 21, Tomah, Wisconsin 54660.

The layoff of our employees has been prompted by declining demand for our products in the marketplace. This action is expected to result in the permanent elimination of 65 employees – 12 salary and 53 hourly positions.

The company expects to begin eliminating positions on March 21, 2016, and will continue in phases until the plant has been idled on approximately May 21, 2016.

The company will ensure that employees will be paid all earned wages and agreed upon benefits at the time of their termination of employment per WI law.
