RE: Notice of Business Closing

Dear Members of the Dislocated Worker Unit:

Olameter DPG, LLC will permanently be closing its facility at 9807 South 13th Street, Oak Creek, WI 53154. The closure has been prompted by the termination of our contract for line locating services at this location by our sole customer in the state, WE Energies.

This action is expected to result in the permanent elimination of 70 employees – 6 salary and 64 hourly positions. The company expects to terminate 62 employees on December 31, 2019 and the remaining 8 employees towards the end of January 2020.

Attached is a list of job titles, number affected within each job title, and the anticipated layoff date for the salaried and hourly workers.

We are currently working with our customer, WE Energies to extend the contract for a few more weeks in order to provide our employees with additional notice. At this point in time, we believe that the termination date will remain December 31, 2019. We understand that this is less than the 60 days' notice required under *Wisconsin Statute 109.07*. Therefore, we will make an additional payment for affected employees following their termination to ensure that they are paid all earned wages as well as what they would have earned 60 days following their notification as of November 25, 2019.
